TARGET AREA: Reading

Target Goal:

The number of Beecher High School students that receive five or higher on the Work Keys reading section will increase from sixty-five percent to seventy-five percent by the end of the 2008-2009 school year.

Descriptors:

1. Implement bell ringers that focus on reading comprehension.
2. Include non-fiction readings across the curriculum.
3. Analyze student deficiencies from the PLAN and make changes in instruction to improve the deficiencies.

TARGET AREA: Mathematics

Target Goal:

The number of Beecher High School students that receive five or higher on the Work Keys math section will increase from sixty-six percent to seventy-five percent by the end of the 2008-2009 school year.

Descriptors:

1. Change scope of math curriculum to include Algebra 1, Geometry, and Algebra II in consecutive years to align curriculum with ACT standards.
2. Analyze student deficiencies from the PLAN and make changes in instruction to improve the deficiencies.
3. Include sample ACT questions on tests and quizzes.
4. Identify "at-risk" students and give them additional tutoring services during homeroom.
